

ASA SER OPEN WATER 2007 GRAND PRIX

- 1) Eligibility: The Grand Prix is open to all swimmers affiliated to an ASA SER club who have reached the age of 13 years as of the 31st December 2007.
- 2) Qualifying events:
 - 1st July - The SER Championships, Southsea (3km)
 - 15th July – Brighton pier to pier (1km)
 - 29th July – Eastbourne (2km)
 - 11th August – Dover Regatta (2km)
 - 9th September - Southsea pier to pier (2km)
- 3) Points: To be awarded to the first three SER women and men swimmers to finish at the qualifying events as follows:-
 - 1st – 7 points
 - 2nd - 3 points
 - 3rd – 1 point
- 4) Grand Prix Awards: To be made at Southsea on the 9th September as follows:-
 - Champion challenge trophies to the woman and man swimmers with the highest number of points over the qualifying events.
 - Individual prizes to the three women and men with the highest points over the qualifying events
- 5) Grand Prix placing if points are equal: In the event of two or more swimmers achieving the same total of Points in the Qualify Events, the upper placing shall be decided by the swimmer who finished in the highest position at the SER Championship competition (NB. If a competitor did not swim at the SER Championships they are no longer a contender).
- 6) In addition to the Open Grand Prix there will be parallel female and male competitions subject to the same conditions in the following Age Groups (taken as of 31st December 2007):-
 - 13 ~ 17 years
 - 18 ~ 24 years
 - 25 ~ 34 years
 - 35 ~ 44 years
 - 45 ~ 54 years
 - 55 ~ 64 years
 - 65 years+

Certificates will be awarded to the three women and men in each age category accruing the highest number of points over the qualifying events.

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
