



Updates/General Information for swim21 accredited clubs – July 2016

During a previous ASA Club Development Management Group meeting (formerly the swim21 National Panel), a decision was made to compile an update following each quarterly meeting (March, June, September and December) and circulate this to all swim21 accredited clubs. The following is the fourth update:-

swim21 Updates:-

- Templates and guidance documents for elements 7, 10 and 17 have been updated in line with Wavepower 2016-2019
- If the portal login page shows information relating to the 2015 Club Conferences please press Ctrl and F5 to refresh this page
- Please note that we do not supply ASA templates for swim21 Performance accreditation, however there is a document outlining the required criteria for each discipline – please contact your Club Development Officer/Regional Officer if you wish to view this
- Element 20 – it is no longer a requirement for the Head Coach/Teacher to complete the IoS online disability CDP and it can now be completed by anyone appropriate within the club
- Please note that if there's no 'green tick' on the swim21 portal 7 days prior to the national Club Development Management Group meeting then a clubs accreditation will lapse unless there are genuine referral cases. This gives time for figures to be put together and referrals to be looked at prior to each meeting. Dates for the next two national meeting are: 28th September and 14th December
- If you have club members/previous members who no longer require access to the swim21 portal please email clubdevelopment@swimming.org and we will deactivate their accounts

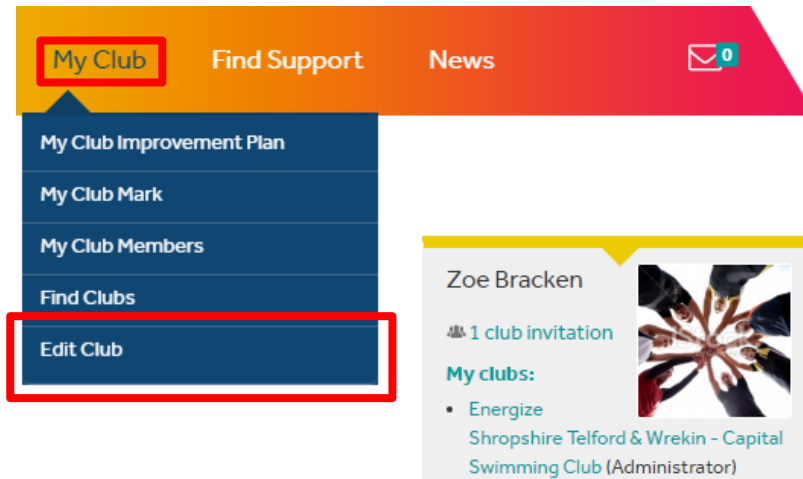
General Updates:-
