# Safeguarding overnight stays

Room allocation on overnight stays can be a challenge. The guidelines we ask clubs to use are the ones in Wavepower and the more detailed advice in Safe Sport Events, Activities and Competitions which is written by the CPSU.

"An 18 year old is legally an adult and we would recommend in most cases that adults do not share rooms with children. However, if you have two swimmers who are swimming friends and one is 17 and the other has just happened to turn 18 as long as the parents of the 17 year old and the 18 year old themselves are comfortable we would not want to stop 2 swimming friends sharing a room.

So as long as consent in place and clear understanding that the 18 year old is not viewed a "responsible adult" and that any concerns are reported in accordance with the responsible staff on the trip that is fine. If the 18 year old didn't know the 17 year old then we would say a definite no. And clearly if the 18 year old held any position of responsibility on the trip a no."
