Teaching & Coaching Qualifications – update on minimum age

ASA / Swim England Level 1 Swimming Assistant (Teaching) – You must be at least 16 years of age. There are no formal entry requirements for this qualification and you do not need any previous experience of teaching.

ASA / Swim England Level 2 Swimming Teacher – You must be at least 16 years of age and hold a level 1 Swimming Assistant in Teaching or equivalent ASA/Swim England qualification certified after 1994.

Swim England Swimming Assistant (Coaching) - You must be at least 16 years of age. There are no formal entry requirements for this qualification and you do not need any previous experience of coaching.

Swim England Swimming Coach – You must be at least 18 years of age and be a Swim England Assistant (coaching) or equivalent.
