Dear Athlete,

Congratulations, you have been selected to attend the 2025/2026 South East regional development programme. Camps will take place on Sunday 7th September 2025 and Sunday 7th June 2026 at ACS International School in Cobham, Surrey.

The programme will engage with 36 athletes, comprised of 18 males and 18 females in the 13-year-old age group (as of the 31st December 2025). Selections have been made using the selection policy which is available on the regional website.

The syllabus for these camps has been prescribed by the Swim England talent team to maintain the development pathway within the sport. For the camp day, athletes will need;

- Swim kit for 2 pool sessions, including kick board, pull buoy, fins and a snorkel.
- Land training kit with suitable footwear
- Pen and paper for making notes.
- Lunch and refreshments for the whole day (water fountains are available, no nuts)

We expect all athletes to attend both camp days. Please confirm your place by completing the booking form and submitting the £50 payment through the South East regional website https://www.southeastswimming.org/regional-development-programme-2025-2026-athlete-registration-form/ by **Friday 25th July.** After this date, reserves will be invited.

Regional Development Camp 2025 Code of Conduct

The purpose of this document is to establish a set of guidelines and procedures, which outline the responsibilities and behaviour of both staff and swimmers who are attending the Regional Development Camps.

Behaviour and Personal Conduct must at all times be of a high standard and reflect favourably on the sport, and the Programme. Language in public or relevant group situations must always be appropriate and socially acceptable.

Attendance at all activities is expected unless agreed by the Team Manager. Throughout the duration of the Camp swimmers should inform staff of their whereabouts. Punctuality on all occasions is essential.

Medication: It is important that information on all medication being currently taken should be reported to the Team Manager immediately on arrival at camp/event who will report it to the relevant personnel.

Injuries: It is essential that camp staff are made aware of any injuries both at the time of booking onto the camp and any changes on the day.

Sanctions:

Breaches of the Code of Conduct shall be dealt with in the first instance by the Team Manager or Head Coach. He/she shall report the incident to the Swim England South East Officer who shall take such further action as is deemed necessary. It is expected that all Swimmers, when attending any camp shall adhere to the swimmer code of conduct as set out in Wavepower.
