

Objectives and Selection Criteria for the swimming Off-shore Camp – 59th International challenge of Geneva – 23rd – 25th January 2026

Objectives

- 1. To provide exposure and experience of overseas competition
- 2. To provide a motivational opportunity for South East athletes

Selection Criteria

- 1. Winners of the individual events listed below at the South East Region short course championships 2025 will be selected:
 - a. 100, 200 backstroke;
 - b. 100, 200 breaststroke:
 - c. 100, 200 butterfly;
 - d. 200, 400 IM;
 - e. 50, 100, 200, 400, 800(female only)/1500(male only) freestyle.
- 2. Further selections, if required, will be made from the second placed athletes. Second placed swims will be ranked by WAP points scored. If athletes are tied in either 2nd or 3rd place, they will be separated by their 2nd highest placed event.
- 3. Athletes placed below third will not be considered.
- 4. Athletes must be in full-time training with a club in the South East Region.
- 5. Athletes must be of the standard to qualify for the selected meet.
- 6. Any athlete selected to represent Swim England or Aquatics GB at a meet within 7 days of the regional camp will be deselected from the team.
- 7. A squad of 24 will be selected (12 female/ 12 male athletes) Unless the number of winners exceeds this number.

The selected athletes will be contacted via club coaches by Wednesday 5th November. If required, reserves will be contacted after the 21st November.
