Top tips for Coaches and Team Managers Withdrawals and medals

- 1. All withdrawals on the day must be done via the QR code. Withdrawals before the event must use the online form published on the website. Withdrawals will not be accepted in any other format.
- 2. In-session finals are scheduled for all events except HDW events.
- 3. A Final 8 fastest swimmers
 B Final next 8 fastest swimmers and 4 reserves
- 4. Finalists will be announced and updated automatically on Meet Mobile if a finalist withdraws and a swimmer is moved into either the A or B final.
- 5. All finalists, including reserves, must withdraw from the finals if they intend not to swim.
- 6. Fines will be issued to swimmers who do not withdraw from an event they don't intend to swim, including the finals. This includes reserves for finals.
- 7. Medals will be given to top 3 placed swimmers in A- Final
- 8. Medals will be awarded to the fastest 3 swimmers in HDW events.
- 9. Medals will be given to the top 3 Junior swimmers (aged 16yrs and under as of 31st of December 2025). These will be identified using the results of A-finalists first, then B finalists, then from the heats. For HDW events these will be identified from the heats.
- 10. Medals will be available for the top 3 swimmers across classifications in the Para events as calculated by those with the highest points.
