Berkshire & South Buckinghamshire ASA Open Water Championships 2026

1. Berkshire & South Buckinghamshire ASA (BSBASA) has designated the Swim England South East Region Open Water Championships 2026, held at Mercers Lake South Nutfield, Redhill RH14EU on Sunday 28th June 2026, as the host event for all events that form the BSBASA Open Water Championships 2026. Championship events and applicable age groups are:
 - i. 2km Freestyle; age groups 12yrs, 13yrs, 14yrs, 15-16yrs and 17-19yrs.
 - ii. 3km Freestyle; age groups 14yrs, 15yrs, 16yrs and 17-19yrs.
 - iii. 5km Freestyle; age groups 16yrs, 17-18yrs and 19yrs+.
2. The published conditions for the Swim England South East Region Open Water Championships 2026 shall govern the management of the event and shall be accepted in their entirety by swimmers who are members of clubs affiliated to BSBASA and who wish to be considered for automatic entry into the BSBASA Open Water Championships 2026.
 - 2.1 The published results from the Swim England South East Region Open Water Championships 2026 shall be accepted as a true record.
 - 2.2 Only swimmers who complete their event and appear on the Swim England South East Region Open Water Championships 2026 results will be eligible for the BSBASA Open Water County Championship 2026 awards.
 - 2.3 Competitors must have been in continuous membership of clubs affiliated to the Association since the 1st December of the year preceding the Championships.
 - 2.4 A competitor who has competed in the Championships of another County shall not be eligible to compete in the Association's Championships in the same discipline in the same calendar year
3. There shall be open/male and female, junior and senior champions in each designated event of the BSBASA Open Water Championships 2026 (supplementary condition 1).
 - 3.1 The Junior open/male and female Champion will be the fastest BSBASA swimmer identified in the published results up to and including 15 years.
 - 3.2 The Senior open/male and female Champion will be the fastest BSBASA swimmer identified in the published results, aged 16 years and over.
4. Medals will be presented during the competition. It is each swimmer's responsibility to collect their awards or arrange for others to collect them. Medals not collected will not be awarded or posted after the event.
 - 4.1 BSBASA Championship medals will be awarded for 1st, 2nd & 3rd places in open/male and female categories for junior and senior championships in all designated competitions.
 - 4.2 BSBASA Age Group medals will be awarded for open/male and female categories for 1st, 2nd & 3rd placed swimmers in each age group identified in each designated competition (Condition 1). *Draft 8 April 2026.*
